

‘Victory 4 All’ Projects

Many children in the informal settlements of Jeffrey’s Bay and Humansdorp, South-Africa live under terrible circumstances. They face hunger, illness, violence, prostitution, a lack of adequate housing and sanitation etc. Often they lose hope and don’t expect their future to be any better than that of their parents. Every day more children are affected by or even orphaned through HIV/Aids.

Good education, which gives children the prospects of a brighter future, is very expensive and therefore inaccessible to the thousands of underprivileged children.

‘Victory4All’ Projects has different programmes offering children quality education unlocking their full potential and giving them hope for the future. The Bible, God’s Word is our standard and we want the children to know that God loves them and created them with gifts and talents that need to be developed. He has a plan for their lives; to give them a hope and a future! (Jer. 29:11)



The founders, Johan and Astrid Vos, a couple from the Netherlands, oversee these projects. They started in 2003 and now have a wonderful team of around 50 local and international staff and volunteers. ‘Victory4All’ Projects is part of Victory Christian Church in Jeffrey’s Bay.

'Noah's Ark' Playschool



This playschool caters for about 140 children between the ages of 1 and 6. Here the children are loved, cared for and stimulated in their development, mainly through playing, creative activities, singing and dancing. The classes are kept small (20 max.) for a lot of personal attention. The children also receive two healthy meals a day.



Rainbow Day-Care

Children with special needs, such as physical and mental disabilities or learning difficulties, deserve to be in a safe place and a loving environment.

Some home situations are very difficult and many of those vulnerable children are often on the streets, all by themselves, which can be extremely dangerous.

The +50 children at RAINBOW are intellectually stimulated, each on their own level, and trained in social skills. They are offered a loving, caring environment and two healthy meals a day. 'Victory4All' has a bus to transport the children from the surrounding areas.



'Victory4All' Christian School



Quality education is expensive in South Africa and 'Victory4All' Projects is meeting this need by offering a high level of Christian education to those who cannot afford this.

The emphasis in this (pré-)primary school is on Spiritual growth and leadership. We firmly believe that good education is a way out of poverty.

There are a maximum of 25 children in each class in order to provide them with more personal attention.



'STARS' afternoon programmes



After school many kids come to the 'Victory4All' Worship Centre to have a vibrant time together with a lot of fun. They worship, dance, sing and play games and receive a message from God's Word. Most of the children are desperate for direction and here they learn how to live by God's principles in order to discover a more fulfilling life.



Holiday Fun!

Every school holiday 'Victory4All' offers a lot of fun for the children in the informal settlements. About 300 children come every morning to enjoy games, scripture memorisation, worship, prayer, singing, dancing and to learn from the Bible via skits or plays.

They enjoy some food and a juice together and take a craft home.

For at least a few hours the children are kept from wandering around in the streets. They learn about Jesus who gave His life for them in order to give them a hope and a future!



Foster Homes

Often children have to be rescued from terrible home situations. Many of them are molested, abused or neglected. They carry the direct consequences of alcohol abuse, sickness, poverty and immorality. Many children are orphaned by Aids.



In each of these 5 'Victory4All' Foster Homes, a maximum of 6 children live in a family setting where a loving mother and a father care for them and give them a new home.
